

POWER: Tackle Pennsylvania's Labor Shortages

Pennsylvania's workforce has a critical talent gap: 60% of jobs require some higher education after high school, but only 51% of workers having the needed degree or credential. PASSHE continues to focus on workforce needs by increasing graduates in business, education, healthcare, and STEM — all fields with high-demand jobs.

PASSHE's Impact

- Nearly 1 in 4 educators in Pennsylvania are PASSHE graduates.
- PASSHE is a major educator of healthcare workers.
- Business is PASSHE's largest academic program, with more than 13,000 students.
