Campus Updates

- IUP is exploring the possible development of a college of osteopathic medicine. If successful, it will be the first medical school of its kind at a public university in Pennsylvania.
- Each IUP student is assigned a Navigator for help with anything from academic support to everyday campus life. As a testament to the success of the Navigators program, IUP's first-to-second-year retention rate has increased by nearly 7 percentage points over the last two years, reaching 78.2 percent.
- IUP has earned the "[Opportunity College and University-Higher Access, Higher Earnings](#)" Carnegie Classifications, which recognizes institutions with graduates who earn salaries that are 50 percent above (or more) than their peers in similar fields and institutions that provide access to students that reflect the communities that they serve.
