



Flu Shot/Vaccine Information

State System Highmark Health Plan Members – No Cost Flu Shot

- You and your covered dependents age 9 and older, can obtain a no-cost flu shot at *any Highmark participating pharmacy*.
- No appointment is necessary – just present your Highmark ID card.
- Be sure to confirm your pharmacy participates with Highmark for flu shots.
- The State System health plan will be billed directly for this service.
- Highmark members of all ages may also obtain a flu shot from their physician. An office visit co-pay may apply.

Additional Immunizations Available at Retail Pharmacies for Highmark Members

Adults (age 18 or over) may receive the following vaccinations *at any Highmark participating pharmacy*. Age and frequency limits will apply as outlined in the preventive schedule¹.

| ✓ Human Papillomavirus (HPV) | ✓ Tetanus, Diphtheria (Td) |

Special note about the coronavirus vaccination: All versions of the vaccine are available at no cost to eligible members including booster shots. You should contact your provider to determine if the booster vaccination is appropriate for you.
