



Mandatory Insurer Reporting Law

Social Security Numbers are required for employees and dependents—The State System will not enroll a dependent without a Social Security Number, except for a newborn. The Mandatory Insurer Reporting Law (Section 111 of Public Law 110–173) requires all insurers to report the Social Security and Medicare health insurance claims numbers of its members who meet certain reporting criteria to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS).

If a dependent is not eligible for a Social Security Number, the employee will be required to provide a letter of explanation from the Social Security Administration. Employees in this situation or with any questions should contact their university human resources office.



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
