² The primary use of these funds will be to provide financial aid assistance to students who have been the most disproportionately impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic; these students will be identified based upon the federal government's definition of the communities/households who were the most disproportionately impacted. In addition to the financial aid assistance, it is anticipated that some of these funds may be used for qualified capital or deferred maintenance projects that respond to the public health emergency and/or negative impacts of the pandemic. Lastly, qualified technology and other allowable expenditures (e.g., services directly impacting the disproportionately impacted students) will use remaining funds.
